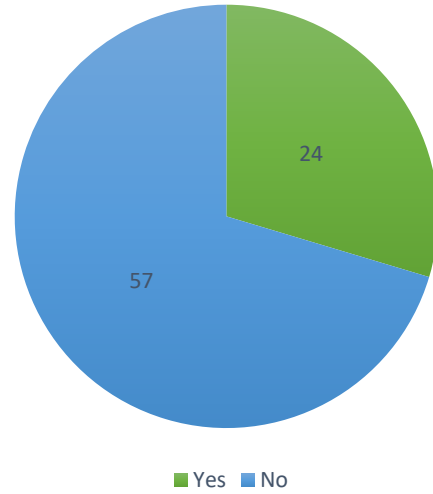
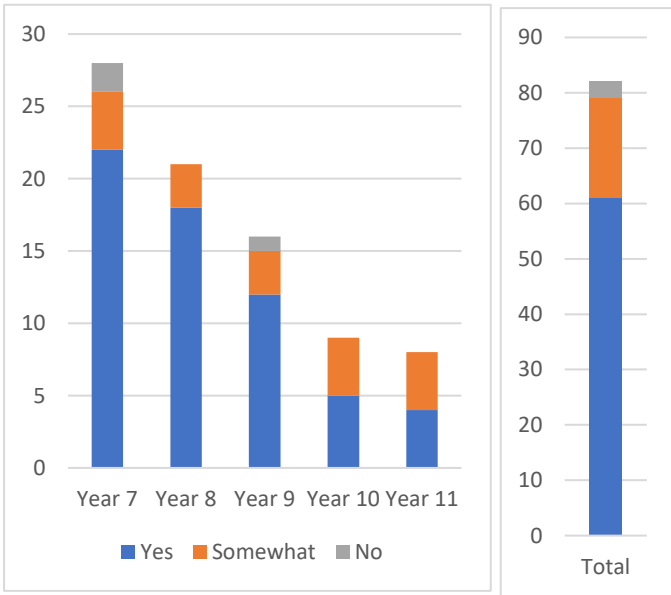

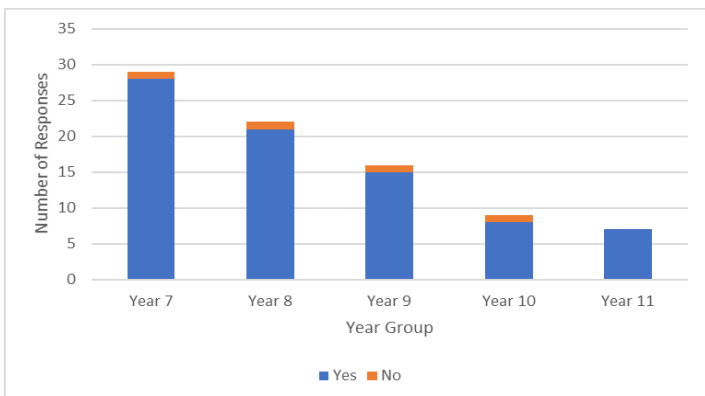

1.1 Do you think your child's wellbeing is supported at school, either through their tutor or the wellbeing team?

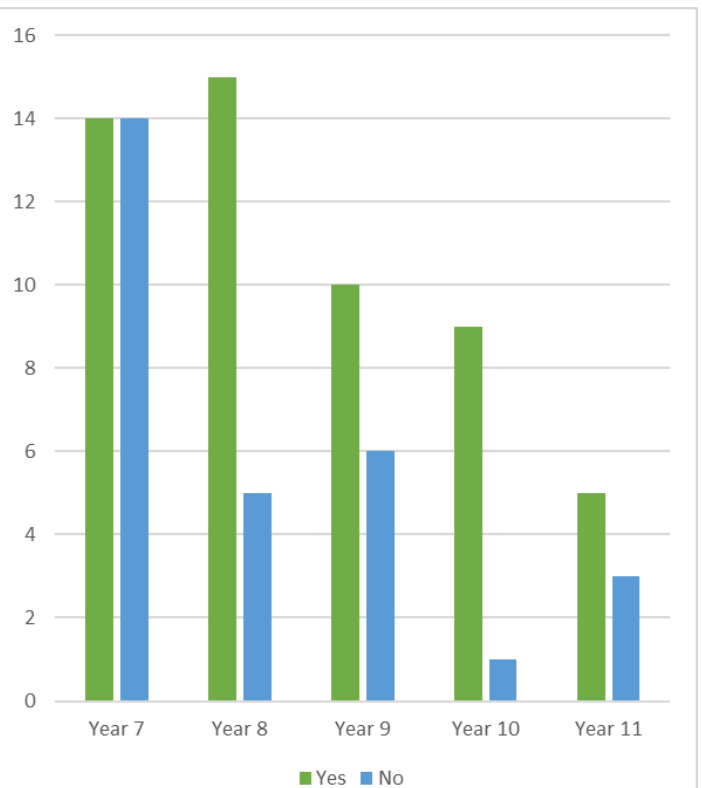
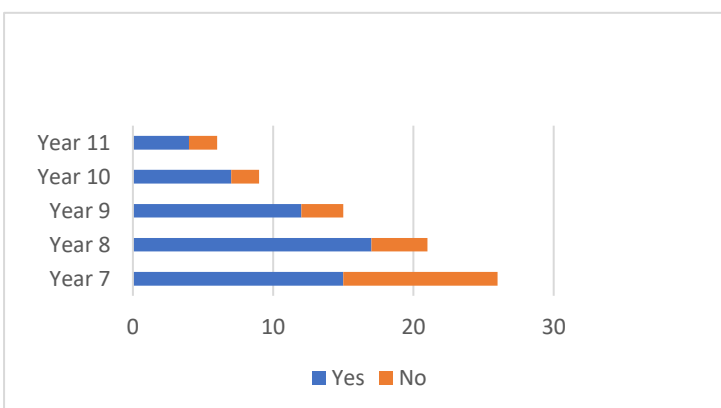
