Uniform Policy

Dear Parent/Carer,

Firstly, all staff at the Academy would like to thank you for your support this past term - we know it has been difficult for many reasons and the resilience of our school community has shone through. After the Christmas break, students will return to the Academy on Tuesday 5th January 2021. January is a great opportunity to reaffirm expectations and as such, we would like to remind students and their families about the Academy's uniform policy. During the past week, tutors and heads of year have been checking uniform every day to ensure that any concerns have been raised and resolved by Monday 11th January 2021, when all students will be expected to be in full uniform as per the interim uniform policy. The Boulevard Academy is committed to supporting all of our students.

If you are experiencing financial hardship, please do speak to the student's Head of Year and we will do our very best to support you.

This following uniform items are permitted:

- ✓ black shoes
- ✓ black trousers
- ✓ a white shirt
- ✓ a plain black or grey rounded or V necked jumper (no logos or PE jumpers)


Please be aware that students are not permitted to wear:

- Boots, trainers (even if all black), vans, etc. If students wear incorrect footwear they will be provided with sandals to wear for the day and will be expected to sit an after-school detention every day until the footwear is correct.
- Hoodies of any variety.
- Black jeans that look like trousers/leggings
- Nose rings and earrings. Only 1 stud can be worn per ear and only clear nose/facial studs are permitted. Bracelets cannot be worn though a single chain representing a religious faith is permitted.
- Make up, nail varnish, false nails
- Brightly dyed hair. Only natural coloured hair is permitted
- Mobile phones can be brought to school but must not be used beyond the school gate. Any phone being used without the permission of the senior leadership team will be confiscated until the end of the Academy day. Repeated mobile phone infractions will see the phone confiscated at the start of a school day.

No student will be sent home if uniform is incorrect. Starting on Monday 11th January, students will sit after school detentions daily until any of the above concerns are corrected.

If anybody has any issues regarding any uniform concerns, they can contact the school where support can be provided in all instances.
