- Hand washing/hand gel available in all classrooms & offices
- All students and staff displaying symptoms advised to self-isolate at home
- Staff and students can use LFT to test at home twice weekly
- No staff or student in the 'at risk' category on site
- All staff and students on site aware of social distancing rules applied
- All cleaning routines have been reviewed in accordance with COVID-19 guidance
- PPE equipment available for staff who have to administer First Aid treatment
