**Class Charts - Important changes to homework and monitoring behaviour**

Dear Parent/Carer,

As your child enters a new Academic year, we'd like to tell you about important changes to how we are setting homework as well as monitoring behaviour. Both aspects will now be run through a new online platform called 'Class Charts'.

Class Charts provides students, parents and teachers detailed information on the merits and sanctions received by a child, including the lesson and cause. Moving forwards, all detentions will also be recorded via Class Charts (replacing our previous method of a phone call home) allowing you to see when and why the detention was set.

Both of these features are accessible to parents from home by using the Class Charts app. Your child has already received details during their tutor time about how to log into Class Charts. Details on how parents/carers can access Class Charts, including your individual access code, are attached to this letter.

Homework is more important than ever due to the recent school closures and at The Boulevard Academy we are determined to raise student attainment through a blended learning approach. Class Charts provides a really useful homework calendar where students can oversee their homework and access necessary resources. Should students fail to complete their homework, they will receive a same day homework detention in which to complete it. This will be communicated to parents/carers via Class Charts.
