Re: Measles, Chicken Pox and Shingles

We are writing to you to ask for your cooperation in a vitally important matter. One of our students has received medical treatment that puts them at serious risk if exposed to measles, chicken pox or shingles.


The best way to protect against measles is for all students to be immunised against them. If your child is not already vaccinated we would ask that you please discuss measles immunisation with your GP. If you suspect your child has measles please inform the school immediately.

Our student is also at risk from chicken pox and would need to be given an injection within three days of contact. Please let us know immediately if you suspect that your child has chicken pox. It is also very important that you let us know if anyone in your household has shingles.

Please note that your own child is not at any risk whatsoever from this situation. However, the health and wellbeing of our student may be at serious risk. We depend on the cooperation of all parents and know we can rely on your help.
