As we start the Summer Term, I would like to thank parents and carers for their continued support regarding Homework. We have seen a significant increase in the completion of homework amongst students. Not only are students working hard to submit their work on time, but also the quality of work has increased.

Homework is more important than ever due to the recent school closures and at The Boulevard Academy we are determined to raise student attainment through a blended learning approach. We are proud of our students, and believe this could not be achieved without your support from home.

The Academy provides a homework club every day in the canteen, between 3:00pm and 5:00pm, where students have access to IT, resources, equipment and teaching staff.
